- Plan, lead and carry out Patrol activities at Patrol meetings, campouts and day events.
- Promote strong Patrol pride and identity by consistently using my Patrol name, emblem and cheer.
- If you cannot attend meetings and/or events, email the Senior Patrol Leader and the Scoutmaster/Assistant Scoutmaster, accordingly.
- Work with other Troop leaders to make the Troop run well.
- Keep Patrol members informed.
- Know the abilities of each Patrol member.
- Assign each Patrol member a specific duty and Patrol leadership position and ensure they understand the expectations.
- Make a special effort to be a good friend to each Scout in my Patrol.
- Keep well ahead of my Patrol in advancement and help my Scouts advance to First Class rank.
- Teach basic Scout skills.
- *Optional:* Work with Patrol towards Honor Patrol.
- Follow the "Be Active" policy and ensure others within the Troop are aware of it.
- Set a good example.
- Proudly wear the Scout uniform correctly and enthusiastically.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Demonstrate Scout Spirit in everything you do.
- Seek performance feedback from your leadership coach (ASM) mid-way through your leadership term.
