- Chair the PLC.
- Attend all Troop meetings, events and the annual program planning meeting, if applicable.
- Ensure proper clean-up after Troop meetings.
- If you are not able to attend meetings or events, email and inform the Scoutmaster accordingly.
- Assign duties and responsibilities to youth leaders and ensure they understand their responsibilities.
- Ensure timely and clear communication of all Troop activities to Scouts and the Scoutmaster, on a monthly basis.
- Introduce new Scouts to Troop operations.
- Assign, with the help of the Scoutmaster and Assistant SPLs, new Scouts to Patrols.
- Assist the Scoutmaster with leadership training of other Scouts, including the ILST course.
- Follow the "Be Active" policy and ensure others within the Troop are aware of it.
- Set a good example.
- Proudly wear the Scout uniform correctly and enthusiastically.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Demonstrate Scout Spirit in everything you do.
- Seek performance feedback from the Scoutmaster every 2 months through your leadership term.
