- Confirm the *new Scout program* and *schedule* and to achieve the *new Scout objectives* with the Senior Patrol Leader (SPL).
- Be present or represented at all new Scout functions, meetings and outings.
- Represent the new Scouts on the PLC and support the *new Scout program* in Troop event planning.
- If you cannot attend meetings and/or events, email and inform the SPL and the Scoutmaster/Assistant Scoutmaster, accordingly.
- Actively plan, with the assigned Assistant Scout Masters, the new Scout hike and the new Scout camp out.
- Work with the Patrol leaders to complete much of the Scout, Tenderfoot and Second Class requirements for all new Scouts before Goshen.
- Support the *new Scout program* at Goshen through instruction and counseling, if applicable.
- Assure timely and clear communication of all new Scout activities to Scouts and Scoutmasters.
- Introduce new Scouts to Troop operations.
- Teach basic Scout skills.
- Follow the "Be Active" policy and ensure others within the Troop are aware of it.
- Set a good example.
- Proudly wear the Scout uniform correctly and enthusiastically.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Demonstrate Scout Spirit in everything you do.
- Seek performance feedback from your leadership coach every 2 months through your leadership term.
